IISc Bangalore: Master of Business Administration (MBA); **IIT Bombay:** Master of Management (M. Mgt.); **IIT Delhi:** MBA with focus on Management Systems; MBA with focus on Tele-communication Systems Management; **IIT Kanpur:** Master of Business Administration (MBA); **IIT Kharagpur:** Master of Business Administration (MBA); **IIT Madras:** Master of Business Administration (MBA); **IIT Roorkee:** Master of Business Administration (MBA).

Eligibility

Criteria for admission to the individual Institutes are given below:

IISc Bangalore: B.E./B.Tech. or equivalent in any branch of Engineering with at least a Second Class. **IIT Bombay:** A First Class degree (Min. 60% aggregate / Min. CGPI of 6.5/10) in either Engineering (Bachelor's degree or equivalent) or Master's degree in Science. **IIT Delhi:** Minimum 60% marks in aggregate (of all the years/semesters) or 6.75/10 CGPA in Bachelor's degree in any branch of Engineering/ Technology/ Architecture/ Pharmacy/ Agriculture Engg.(min 4 years after 10+2) or Master's degree in Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Applications, Electronic Science, Environmental Science, Operations Research, Computational/Information Science, Agriculture, Commerce, Economics. There is a relaxation of 5% in marks or equivalent in CGPA for SC/ST candidates. **IIT Kanpur:** B.E./B.Tech. in any branch of Engineering with 60% marks in aggregate or CGPA of 6.0/10.0 in aggregate based on average over whole programme. Candidates with Architecture degree can also apply provided they have taken Mathematics at 10+2 level. **IIT Kharagpur:** First Class Bachelor's degree in any branch of Engineering/Technology or a first class Master's degree in Science, Economics or Commerce (with Mathematics or Statistics at Bachelor's level). **IIT Madras:** First Class or equivalent in B.E./B.Tech./Master's degree in any discipline from a recognized Institution or University. **IIT Roorkee:** Bachelor's degree in any discipline of Engineering / Technology or its equivalent or a Master's degree in any discipline from a recognized Institute/University with at least 60% marks (55% marks for SC/ST) in aggregate or CGPA of 6.00 on a 10 point scale (5.50 on a 10 point scale for SC/ST).

Note: Candidates appearing for final examinations for the qualifying degree can also apply. However, they have to complete all requirements for the qualifying degree and produce a provisional certificate before a date specified by the admitting Institute.

Reservation: As per Govt. of India rules.

JMET Brochure, Application Form and Submission

There are two different processes by which a candidate can apply for JMET 2008, namely, "online" and "offline". The Application Fee is **Rs. 750** for the online process and **Rs. 800** for the offline process. Only for SC/ST candidates, the Application Fee is **Rs. 350** for online process and **Rs. 400** for offline process. **The Application Fee is not refundable.**

Online submission of application can be made by accessing the website <http://gate.iitkgp.ac.in/jmet>. The candidate should pay the Application Fee through SBI ATM or through a Demand Draft in favour of 'IIT Kharagpur' on any nationalised bank payable at 'Kharagpur, West Bengal'. The candidate should enter the payment details while filling up the Online Application Form. After successful submission of data the candidate should take a printout of the Online Application Form. The candidate is required to sign the printed Online Application Form, affix photograph at the appropriate place, attach the Demand Draft / duly signed photocopy of original ATM transaction-slip and other relevant documents and send it ONLY to **The Chairman GATE, IIT Kharagpur, Kharagpur 721 302**. These steps complete the Online Application procedure.

Offline process involves procuring the Information Brochure and Application Form by one of the following modes:

- By Post** – In this mode, a Demand Draft for the amount, as stated above, along with a request letter and two self-addressed slips is to be sent to the Chairman of any GATE office. This facility is available at IISc and all IITs.
- In person from GATE offices** – In this mode, a Demand Draft for the amount is to be submitted to the GATE office during working hours. This facility is available only at IISc Bangalore, IIT Bombay, IIT Guwahati and IIT Kharagpur.
- In person from bank counters** - In this mode, cash payment is to be made at the banks. This facility is available only at IIT Delhi (Canara Bank, Extension Counter, IIT Delhi), IIT Kanpur (Union Bank of India, IIT Kanpur Branch), IIT Madras (State Bank of India, IIT Madras Branch) and IIT Roorkee (Punjab National Bank, IIT Roorkee Branch).

More information about the eligibility, programmes, test cities, test structure, etc. is available at the websites of IISc and all IITs. Filled in Application Form along with the pay-in-slip from bank / GATE office must be sent ONLY to **The Chairman GATE, IIT Kharagpur, Kharagpur 721 302**.
